HUNTING CONDITIONS 2019

1. The hunts offered are for a maximum of two persons. No additional persons will be allowed unless special permission is obtained from the Municipality.
2. Hunters will be submitted to a simple test of shooting ability on the first day of the hunt. Only rifles of caliber of 6 mm or 243 or higher may be used for Blesbuck, Impala, Springbok and Fallow Deer and 7 mm or higher for larger animals.
3. All hunters will be accompanied by a guide who will not be responsible for pointing out the species or sex of the animals.
4. Should a hunter shoot the wrong specie or sex, he will forfeit the carcass and pay for the animal/s.
5. Consumption of liquor will not be allowed while hunting and no hunting will take place from a vehicle. A lot of walking may be required, therefor the hunter should be reasonably fit.
6. Hunting package dates set out as per Tender must be followed and can't be changed accept for weather conditions.
7. All hunters must be in possession of a hunting license.
8. All hunters must sign a declaration of indemnity.
9. Hunting will only be allowed on the Wednesday following a package should an animal be wounded during the previous two days.
10. Recovery vehicle and staff will be provided free of charge.
11. Where non-trophy animals are stated the animals are mature.
12. Payment of successful bidders is as follows: 50% to be paid immediately as a deposit on confirmation of the hunt. The remaining 50% to be paid by bank guaranteed cheque or cash before or on the morning before the commencement of the hunt.

14. Proof of 50% deposit and remaining 50% payment must be showed to Reserve Manager on the day of hunting, if not NO HUNTING.
15. The provisions of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (No5 of 2000) and Regulation pertaining thereto as well as Enoch Mgijima Municipalities Procurements Policy will apply to these bids.
